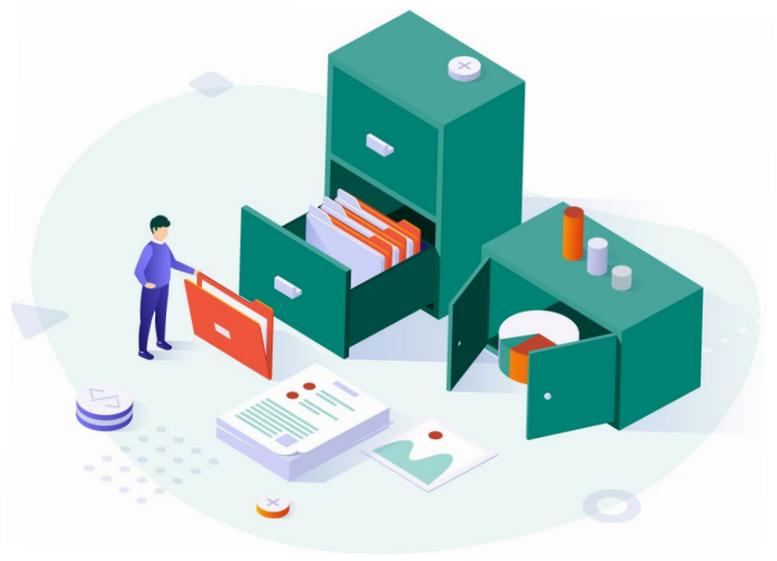
How Does it Work?
